

Eleanor H. Fuhrman Memorial Scholarship

Eleanor Fuhrman's teaching career was spent in rural schools in Stanton and Wayne counties for 20 1/2 years, Hoskins Public School for 4 years and for Norfolk Public Schools for 26 years. She served as a teaching principal for 9 years and for 17 years as an elementary media coordinator where she was responsible for making eight libraries and a central media center with catalogs for each one. Mrs. Fuhrman taught three semesters of night classes at Northeast Community College, teaching Children's Literature. She was an active member of her community and church. Mrs. Fuhrman passed away in 2008.

Selection Criteria:

1. Must be a student of Norfolk Public Schools
2. Program of future study: Education
3. GPA of 85% or higher
4. Must be enrolled for at least 12 hours per semester.
5. A written recommendation from a NPS faculty/staff member.
6. Student shall have demonstrated volunteer service within the community.
7. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Committee.
