Selection Criteria:

1. Student is required to have been enrolled at Norfolk Public Schools for a minimum of three years.
2. College program of study: a four year degree in the field of education.
3. Minimum GPA of 82% or greater.
4. A minimum college enrollment of 12 hours per semester.
5. One written recommendation from a NPS staff member with a focus on good citizenship and work habits.
6. Volunteer Community Service will be considered.
7. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Selection Committee.
