Must be used for the remission of tuition, fees, room, or board. This scholarship will be awarded upon notification of acceptance prior to the beginning of the first semester of the academic year.

Selection Criteria:

1. Applicants must be pursuing a career/course of study in a service profession as defined above.
2. Secondary selection criteria will give preference to a student with a personal relationship to the International FOE (any chapter). For example, a parent or grandparent that was a FOE member in any chapter around the world. This is not required to apply.
3. Must write a personal essay (see application).
4. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Committee with a recommendation given by the FOE Auxiliary #3611 chapter.
