3. Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from NHS faculty or staff member.
4. Applicants must exhibit strong leadership qualities in school and community endeavors.
5. Applicants must complete an essay question - Please describe a topic, activity, or cause that you are passionate about. How do you plan to develop this interest further in college and how could it be used in your future profession?
6. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Committee, with recommendation given by Marissa Heimes.
