Selection Criteria:

1. Applicants must be attending a 4 year college/university and enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.
2. Applicants must have a minimum 90% GPA to apply and consideration will be given to ACT score.
3. Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from NHS faculty or staff member.
4. Applicant must exhibit outstanding character and strong leadership qualities in school and community endeavors.
5. Applicant must complete an essay question (see application).
6. All programs of study are encouraged to apply. In the event of a tie between multiple candidates, secondary criteria preference will be given to students pursuing a health-related field.
7. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Committee, with recommendation given by Morgan Heimes.
