

Norfolk High School Music Booster Scholarship

The Norfolk High School Music Boosters offer scholarships annually to graduating seniors that have participated in extra-curricular music during their time at Norfolk High School. This includes all bands, choirs, and orchestra. (This is defined as participation in at least one music ensemble, including band, jazz band, choir, show choir, or orchestra.)

Must be used for remission of tuition, fees, room & board, books, and/or equipment related to the student's area of study. This scholarship will be awarded upon notification of acceptance prior to the beginning of the first semester of the academic year.

Selection Criteria:

1. Student must have participated in NHS extra-curricular music, including all bands, choirs, and orchestra. (This is defined as participation in at least one music ensemble, including band, jazz band, choir, show choir, or orchestra.)
2. Must write a personal essay (see application).
3. Must submit a letter of recommendation from someone that is not a family member, nor is affiliated with the school district. The person writing the recommendation must address the applicant's personal character.
4. In the event that multiple applicants seem equally qualified based on above criteria, secondary criteria preference should be given to the student that is pursuing a college program of study in music (major or minor).
5. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Committee
