

## Middle School NSCAS and MAP Achievement Results



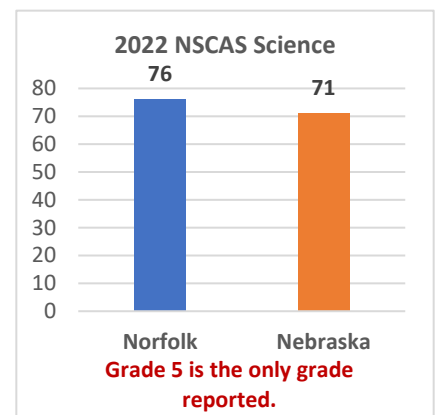
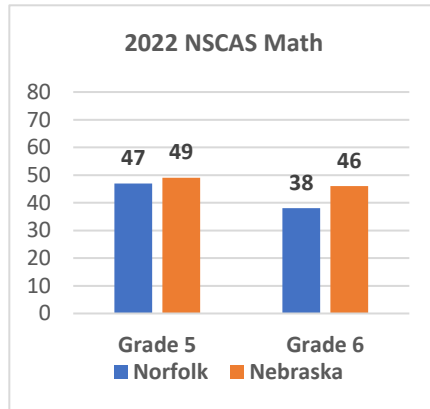
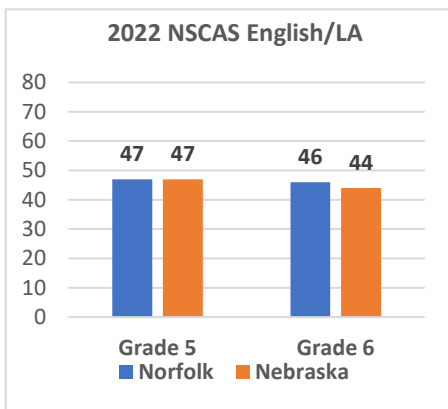
- Both the U.S. News and World Report and WalletHub rank Nebraska as the 9<sup>th</sup> best state for K-12 education.
